COVID-19 (Coronavirus): Visitor Policy

In response to the global Coronavirus outbreak, Loughborough Schools Foundation has implemented a strict visitor policy to safeguard the health and wellbeing of the whole Foundation community.

Our policy has been developed in accordance with the advice and guidance given by Public Health England (PHE), the Boarding Schools' Association (BSA) and the Medical Officer of Schools Association (MOSA), supported by our in-house medical teams.

Given the close-knit environment in our Schools and boarding houses where viruses could be transmitted easily, our number one priority is to safeguard the health and wellbeing of our pupils/students, staff and the wider community, and this policy forms part of the measures we are implementing to support this.

Please only visit if it is essential and you have an appointment.

Please do not visit if any of the following applies to you:

- has tested positive for Covid-19 within the last 5 days, or are awaiting a PCR test or a PCR test result;
- has a new continuous cough;
- has a high temperature; or
- has a loss of sense of smell or taste; or
- generally, feel unwell.

All visitors must note the following:

- You are asked to observe all the guidelines on good hygiene, any specific displayed instructions, and all other signage in place at the buildings/locations that you are visiting.
- You must only enter any areas that you have been given permission to enter
- You are recommended to wear a face covering in indoor settings when you meet people you don't normally meet.
