The Worshipful Company of Plaisterers' Harry Humber Music Scholarship is available for a Sixth Form musician living in travelling distance with a household income of £40,000 (or demonstrating financial need) or less wishing to attend Loughborough Grammar School, Loughborough High School or Loughborough Amherst School in September 2022.

The Award

The scholarship will provide £7,500 a year towards tuition fees with the opportunity to top up to 100% based on financial need.

As a condition of the award, the recipient will perform at Plaisterers' Hall once a year. We will also provide The Worshipful Company of Plaisterers' with an annual update on the scholar's progress during their time in Sixth Form.

Numerous Music-Making Opportunities

There are currently over 50 instrumental ensembles and choirs, including three orchestras and several chamber music ensembles, which rehearse each week. Performances take place regularly, either in School, the local community or further afield. Annual concerts take place in Leicester's de Montfort Hall, and in recent years we have toured Prague, Barcelona, Geneva, Cornwall and in July 2023 will be touring the Loire Valley.

The Harry Humber Sixth Form Music Scholarship is available to a pupil who shows great musical potential and has the potential to thrive at Loughborough Grammar School, Loughborough High School or Loughborough Amherst School. We welcome applications from pupils with a strong commitment to their music making, who would make the most from the extraordinary musical opportunities on offer at Loughborough Schools Foundation and contribute to ensembles or choirs. As a guide, award holders will be roughly grade 7 level and above. Applicants will be required to demonstrate their musical ability as well as financial need.
