The **Harry Humber Music Scholarship** will be awarded to a musician showing exceptional promise, commitment and ambition on one or more instruments, or voice. Scholarships provide the framework for a comprehensive partnership between the pupil and School. This scholarship is tenable for the duration of the student's Sixth Form at the Loughborough Schools Foundation and is subject to annual review. There are many benefits to being a scholar. You would have bespoke support offered to help you along your musical journey, as well as carrying the status of being a 'Music Scholar.' Scholars must be enthusiastic and able musicians, who can demonstrate their passion for the subject as well as their technical skill. They will be mentored throughout their school journey to ensure they become the best musicians that they can be. The Harry Humber Music Scholar will receive £7,500 a year towards tuition fees, which may be increased to 100% based on individual financial need. They will also receive free instrumental tuition on up to two instruments/voice and be expected to contribute to the department through performances and ensemble/choir membership.

Once your application is accepted you may then be invited to attend a scholarship audition on Tuesday 28 June 2022. In the audition you will be required to perform two pieces or songs on your principal instrument or voice, and a single piece or song on any additional instruments or voice. Candidates not offering voice will be required to sing an unaccompanied song, for example a folksong or hymn. You will also be asked to complete sight reading and aural tests, and have a discussion about musical interests, experience and ambition with the Director of Music.
