

The Tilsley Sixth Form Scholarship

The Opportunity

The Tilsley Sixth Form Scholarship provides a wonderful opportunity for a Sixth Former with a household income of £40,000 (or demonstrating financial need) or less, wishing to attend Loughborough Amherst School in September 2023.

The Award

The scholarship is funded by a generous donation from an OLCS (Our Lady's Convent School) alumna and, with additional SAP (School Assisted Place) funding from Loughborough Amherst School, could cover up to 100% of school fees.

As a condition of the award the holder will commit to a written update in their first term and at the end of each school year to share with the donor the opportunities they have had thanks to the funding, and the difference the scholarship has made to them.

Criteria

In addition to a household income of £40.000 or less (or significant financial need) the scholarship applicant should be able to demonstrate through school reports, predicted GCSE grades, and co-curricular endeavours that they would thrive at Loughborough Amherst School and embrace all the opportunities open to them. Although not a requirement of the award a musical background could be advantageous.

Sixth Form at Amherst


