



Harry Humber **Sixth Form Music Scholarship 2024** 

## The Opportunity

The Worshipful Company of Plaisterers' Harry Humber Music Scholarship is available for a Sixth Form musician living in Leicestershire or Nottinghamshire with a household income of £40,000 (or demonstrating financial need) or less wishing to attend Loughborough Grammar School, Loughborough High School or Loughborough Amherst School in September 2024.

#### The Award

The scholarship will provide £7,500 a year towards tuition fees with the opportunity to top up to 100% based on financial need.

As a condition of the award, the recipient will perform at Plaisterers' Hall once a year. We will also provide The Worshipful Company of Plaisterers' with an annual update on the scholar's progress during their time in Sixth Form.

# **Inspiring Teaching**

Our instrumental teachers, many of whom balance teaching with successful performing careers, teach over 700 individual instrumental and singing lessons a week within the department. Pupils achieve outstanding results in their academic music studies and have a huge range of options for music-making outside the classroom.

### **World Class Facilities**

The Music department houses individual studios, ICT suites, keyboard labs, seminar rooms, two state of the art recording studios and a 120-seater Recital Hall. We are an All-Steinway School, meaning that all our pianos are Steinway or designed by Steinway, with grand pianos in all of our performance spaces.

### **Numerous Music-Making Opportunities**

There are currently over 50 instrumental ensembles and choirs, including three orchestras and several chamber music ensembles, which rehearse each week. Performances take place regularly, either in School, the local community or further afield. Annual concerts take place in Leicester's de Montfort Hall, and in recent years we have toured Prague, Barcelona, Geneva, Cornwall and in July 2024 will be touring the Loire Valley.

### What We're Looking For

The Harry Humber Sixth Form Music Scholarship is available to a pupil who shows great musical potential and has the capability to thrive at Loughborough Grammar School, Loughborough High School or Loughborough Amherst School. We welcome applications from pupils with a strong commitment to their music making, who would make the most from the extraordinary musical opportunities on offer at Loughborough Schools Foundation and contribute to ensembles or choirs. As a guide, award holders will be roughly grade 7 level and above. Applicants will be required to demonstrate their musical ability as well as financial need. Those wishing to be considered should apply by contacting the Registrar in the relevant school.
