Subject Entry Requirements: Grade 6 in GCSE English and GCSE Maths advised.

Subject outline

The subject is geared towards problem solving and encourages students to develop a critical understanding of organisations, the context in which they operate, the markets they serve and the process of adding value; the internal and external business environment and deals with major topical issues that can generate change for business organisations and the ways in which businesses respond to these issues.

How is the course assessed?

3 x 2 hours (this is a linear A Level, and the entire content is examined at the end of the 2-year course)
