What is the exam board and route?

A Level Drama & Theatre, Edexcel

Subject Entry Requirements: Grade 7 in GCSE Drama and/or GCSE English required.

Subject outline

A Level Drama & Theatre is 3 Components

Devising using the practitioner Forced Entertainment and stimulus of a chosen text. Text in Performance is a scripted group piece and a monologue or duologue. Finally Theatre Makers in Practice.

How is the course assessed?

There are 2 exams - Text on performance is practical, you perform a teacher directed group piece and a self-directed monologue or duologue, or you can take the technical route for either or both option.

Theatre Makers in Practice has 2 Sections. Section A: you write a Live Theatre Evaluation of a play seen. Section B is 2 questions answering one as performer and one as a designer on Accidental Death of an Anarchist which is a chosen set text. Section C answered as a director applying the immersive techniques of Punchdrunk Theatre Company to the set text of Woyzeck.

Why study this subject?

Drama requires a creative mind-set, motivation and the ability to communicate effectively. What it says to a prospective university is that you can present yourself confidently, analyse text for meaning and have the resilience to respond to constructive criticism.
