Subject Entry Requirements: Grade 7 in GCSE PE or GCSE Biology advised

Subject outline

The course investigates the physiological, sociological and psychological aspects of physical activity & sport. The course is a theoretical subject, with occasional opportunities to apply learning in practical settings. The course involves an assessment of your sporting ability in your chosen sport, as well as your ability to apply your knowledge of your sport and understanding of the course content within an oral assessment.

How is the course assessed?

Paper 1: Physiology (90 marks/120 minutes/x1 weighting)

Paper 2: Psychology (60 marks/60 minutes/x1 weighting)

Paper 3: Sociology (60 marks/60 minutes/x1 weighting)

Non-Examined Assessment: Evaluation & Analysis for Performance Improvement (oral presentation - 30 Marks/ x1.5 weighting)

Performance or Coaching of chosen Sport (30 marks/ x1 weighting)
